The master's degree in Meteorology of the University of Barcelona is intended for university graduates who are interested in obtaining a solid training in meteorology.

The course includes different subjects that forms the atmospheric sciences: physical meteorology, dynamic meteorology, micrometeorology, cloud physics, radiation, modelling, weather analysis and forecast, atmospheric pollution, climate physics, radar, meteorological risks and climate change, among others.
