



Applications for the 2025-2026 academic year have two periods:

- ▶ First period: From January 13 to March, 17, 2025. Resolutions on April 10, 2025.
- ▶ Second period: From March 18 to April 30, 2025. Resolutions on May 30, 2025.

To apply for the doctoral programme in Economic History at the University of Barcelona, the candidate must follow these steps:

FIRST

Confirm that you meet the admission requirements specified in the ['admission requirements and criteria'](#) section.

SECOND

Complete the [online application form](#) and upload the necessary supporting documents.

1. ID/Passport
2. CV
3. Bachelor's degree transcript of grades and diploma certificate
4. Master's degree transcript of grades (provisional or final version) and diploma certificate (if you have it)
5. Letter of motivation (description of your background; motivation to pursue the interuniversity PhD programme in Economic History at UB; academic interests; research and teaching experience; professional and academic goals).
6. Research proposal (maximum 3 pages)
7. Master thesis (if you are currently working on your Master thesis, please send an extended abstract— typically around 3 pages)
8. Proof of English level (not compulsory if you are a native speaker or you hold a university degree completely taught in English)

THIRD

To provide us with your references, [fill in this form](#) and include the names and contact emails of two scholars endorsing your application. They'll receive an automated email with general questions about your profile. References must be submitted before the corresponding application deadline, specifically within seven days, to be considered.

FOURTH

Once you have completed steps 1 to 3, our admissions team will review your application. You will receive an email notifying you whether everything is in order or if any additional documents or information are required.

Please note that **only complete applications will be considered by the Academic Committee.**

Admission decisions will be communicated via email. Applicants with academic documents from outside Spain will be subject to a €218.15 administrative review fee. Detailed information will be provided to admitted students.
